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deep treatment

Apart from retinoids, the only other ingredient that's been shown to stimulate collagen and tighten pores is glycolic acid. As an additional immediate benefit, it removes rough dead skin cells to give skin a smoother appearance. One of the most cost-effective ways to incorporate glycolic acid into your skincare regimen is to get a non-self-neutralizing glycolic acid wash, like Jan Marini Bioglycolic Facial Cleanser. The longer you leave it on, the deeper the treatment you get. After removing makeup with a gentle cleanser, apply the glycolic wash to dry skin like a mask and leave it on for 1-5 minutes before buffing it away with a clean, damp washcloth. Rinse your face thoroughly with water, and then apply moisturizer.
